


The High Price of NICU Care Nationwide

Across the United States, NICU admissions are associated with significant costs and variable outcomes.

NICU Admission Cost

Nationally, the average cost of a NICU admission is approximately **\$71,158**, but actual costs can range from \$4,488 to \$161,929 for stays ranging from 3 to 34 days.



NICU Length of Stay (LOS)

NICU length of stay is a key indicator of neonatal acuity and care progression. Across all gestational ages, the **average LOS for preterm infants is 24 days**.



Hospital Readmission Rates

Hospital readmission rates after NICU discharge are also notable with **Medicaid-insured infants** consistently demonstrating higher hospital readmission rates compared to **Commercially insured infants**.
